Conditions for group skipasses

The group discount on skipasses applies to groups of a minimum of 10 people for the same area and the same number of days. The skipasses must be purchased and paid directly from the group leader. School groups with authorized order form by school management. School groups: one free skipass for a teacher per 10 students.

Refunds

The Jungfrau Ski Region does not grant refunds on purchased skipasses in the event of any interruption of operations, accident or illness. You have the option of purchasing a ski pass insurance policy. This type of insurance allows you to claim reimbursement from the relevant insurance in the event of an incident. Ski passes as well as hiking and sledging passes can be cancelled free of charge until the day before.

No extension of Hiking & Sledging Passes.

Peak season rates apply only to adults. Children and young people receive the standard fares for the entire season. Senior citizens receive adult fares. If the season times overlap, the fare on the date of the first day of validity applies.
